

The Coronado Navy Swim Association (CNSA), located in Coronado, CA, has an opening for an experienced *Head Coach*. The ideal candidate will have a strong coaching background and extensive experience teaching technique with aerobic development in age group coaching. The ideal coach will have a strong work ethic, good communication skills, solid administrative skills, and have enthusiasm and passion for helping swimmers maximize their swimming potential. The head coach will develop a group philosophy and educate coaches on team philosophy for different groups so that there is one standard formula for each group on the club. In addition, the head coach would contribute to the team mission of recruiting and retaining swimmers and creating new member programming to increase membership.

The head coach will manage and educate three to four assistant coaches, and is responsible for 100 + age group swimmers- ages 6-18. The head coach is expected to have a working knowledge of computers and specifically “Hy-tek” – the swim meet software used in San Diego.

The successful candidate will be working with various practice groups; swimming weekdays between 4:00pm – 6:00pm, various morning practices including Saturdays and weekend swim meets as scheduled. The coach will also develop daily, weekly and seasonal plans for workouts and goals of the season.

The specific hours and job duties will be determined during the interview process. Applicants should be U.S. citizens and hold current coaches safety, CPR, first aid certification, and successfully pass a background check. ASCA level 2 preferred.
