SI BOD Meeting - November 2020

General Chair Report - Sally Taggart

2019 – 2020 Year End: Presentation is attached and will be reviewed. All teams should be proud.

COVID-19:

- Teams are doing a great job managing workout groups / communication with teams / safety and getting times for the swimmers. Thanks to all.
- Priorities for LSC remain 1) working within the public health rules and guidelines 2) safety for our swimmers, coaches, and families and 3) staying out of the press
- Lots of discussion about what can be next with other LSC in California and USA swimming but it will be dependent of spread of disease locally and ultimately vaccine availability
- Time Trial Fees through Pandemic (adjusted to account for wide range in how teams are running these):
 - Sanction Fee remains as is (\$25 to team trial; \$50 if two team trial)
 - LSC Run Time Trials: Splash fee will be fixed amount per swimmer based off the number of allowed events. LSC will provide admin / timing equipment / meet and starter officials / teams to provide officials to the extent possible / timers for lanes that teams will be swimming in.
 - Team Time Trials when LSC timing equipment and timing support is used: \$2 / splash
 fee. Note: if team chooses to do prelim / final format for time trials; then finals splashes

are counted separately (as an example... 36 kids swam 100 fly in prelims / 8 swim 100 fly as finals then 44 splashes). LSC will provide meet and starter officials; team will provide rest of support.

 Team Time Trials when LSC timing equipment / timing support is NOT used: \$1 / splash fee. Note if team chooses to do prelim / final format for time trials; then finals splashes are counted separately. LSC will provide meet and starter officials; team will provide rest of support for meet.

Don Watkinds scholarship: application should be on website this week. Need one athlete and non-athlete to review application in early January and make a decision on who should receive scholarships.

Mental Health seminar held in October for coaches. If interested in having another one, please contact Cathy Elgas and we can do so.

Mental Health Taskforce: met once with coaches and swimmers. Suggestion is that the swimmers can own meeting and talking about what would be helpful. One thing that we will do is expand information and put on our website. Lots of energy among the swimmers and how to help each other which is great. Note: pulled for agenda item

Treasurer's Report - John McGlynn

Proposed Budget is attached separately. Assumptions are:

- Reg income will be down slightly due to COVID
- We will not have to pay senior travel during winter, since they will be regional events (if held at all)
- We will hopefully offer some kind of short course championship meet
- If there is a return to normal, Splash-n-Dash and LCJO's will be our LSC hosted meets
- No all star meet this year
- Reduced funding for athlete recognition, but kept club support a bit on high side
- Up'd the withdraw from investment to 45K to balance the income and expense.

- 1. Tax Returns have been filed to ensure SI retains non exempt status
- 2. Work has started on getting auditor to complete USA swimming requirements. We should expect to make some improvement to how we currently do things and document processes as these always come out of audits ~ note we are lucky that we have some

New Equipment

- The LSC purchased 2 USB extenders for the new timing system.
 - The new system required USB extenders that were more rigorous in their USB protocol implementation.
 - This is a requirement for when the meet manager computer is far away from the timing computer. These extenders allow for 100 meters of distance.
 - o These were approved and paid for out of the General Chair's discretionary budget.

Operational Risk Report - Keith Clements

Pools open for camps and we have had excellent results with limited Covid 19 activity, but better yet very good response when a swimmer has contracted or been exposed to Covid from outside the Swim POD.

We had 9 different teams with an incident, but only 3 swimmers had a positive test and the other 2 swimmers either had a roommate or parent with a positive test. We have had no community outbreaks with any of our swim teams. Each coach handled it exceptionally well and the parents were even more supportive of the coach and teams.

I continue to work with the Board & USA Swimming to get direction on where we might be going in the Covid 19 Era. We are waiting for the Governor to allow competitions, but until that time we must continue to be conservative with our approach to swim meets. Will continue to work with the Board and USA Swimming, but will need the ok from the state or county to move forward. Times trials might be happening and those will be limited to teams or teams without any spectators.

Technical Planning Vice Chair - Pete Murphy

Guidelines for LSC Run Time Trials were approved by the board via email vote and are as follows:

Facility is assumed to be a 10 lane pool with good deck space and can be modified if more lanes

General Format:

o Either one or two teams will be conducting time trials at the same time.

- One Team: Eight lane used / 3 warm up lanes / limited to about 60 kids in a session
- Two Teams: Six lanes used with teams assigned lanes to use throughout session / assigned cool down lanes to use to ensure separation in pool / separate warm up lanes / limit of 60 kids / separate assigned deck space area

Safety protocols:

- All athletes will be required to provide form with the general COVID questions around symptom management / contact with known or possible COVID cases etc.
- o All athletes / officials / timers will be temperature checked before they enter the facility
- o Between each session, all equipment will be sanitized and bathrooms cleaned / wiped down
- Standard mask wearing / social distancing on deck will be required
- No spectators will be allowed.

Senior Vice Chair - Dan Peck

- 1) Request to include any AZ meet in the Winter Championships window was submitted.
 - Reasons to Support: This is one of the only places where you can get a "real feel" meet to submit to the championships.
 - Reasons to Not Support: The LSC is providing an opportunity to race locally and a trip to AZ is an
 optional expense; participating in these events is expressly stated as against state and local
 public health guidelines.
