Financials Caveats

- Lots of Unknowns for this year and next year:
 - Membership numbers and fees (Seasonal handling)
 - Ability to hold meets "as normal" until next summer
 - What will be the longer term needs from the teams as this continues to evolve
 - As an LSC, need to retain flexibility in our options right now

Return to Pool / Meet Schedules

- Still unclear when majority of teams will be in the water
- Hopeful for "around June 1st"
- Will know more about options after tomorrow
 - If unsuccessful in getting pools open for lap swimming, interest in starting a letter writing campaign from swimmers and families?
- Will follow USA swimming guidance & roadmap
 - June Return to practice
 - July Small competitions; virtual meets
 - August Potential for regional meets; unclear what we can do
 - Meet Planning
 - Unfortunately in the situation that until we have teams in the water it is limited in what we can do
 - Does the board want to vote to cancel the rest of the season "as is" at this point.
