Safe Sport:

The USA Swimming Safe Sport program is USA Swimming's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to creating a healthy and positive environment free from abuse for all its members. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandatory reporting of violations.

MAAPP:

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All 18 and older athletes registered with the club must have completed the Athlete Protection Training. Failing to complete the APT test will impact the athlete's ability to compete at meets or have their times loaded into SWIMS. Violations of MAAPP can result in person(s) being asked to leave the facility immediately by the meet director or the meet referee. If this happens, person(s) will not be allowed to return through the rest of the meet.

The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (<a href="www.usaswimming.org/maapp">www.usaswimming.org/maapp</a>) prohibits Adult Participants (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult participant. Adult Participants are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

APT for Athletes 17 years and older: Effective September 1, 2022, there will no longer be a 30-day administrative grace period.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a

USA: Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or
after December 15, 2024, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the <u>first</u>
day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such
time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who
turns age 18 on or after December 15, 2024, who competes in this USA Swimming
sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for
qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

A notification should be sent to any athletes flagged in the meet recon report notifying the athlete, of the need to complete the requirement(s) and that if the requirement(s) are not completed prior to the start of the meet that the athlete will be prohibited from participating. This notification should be copied to the athletes' club head coach.

# Facility Safe Sport:

At this time swimmers, coaches, workers, officials, and parents will be allowed in the pool area. There may be designated area(s) for athletes, coaches, and meet personal.

#### Venue:

Fallbrook High School, 2400 S. Stage Coach Lane, Fallbrook CA. 92028. The pool is located at the back side of the school off Winterhaven and Mission Rd. Please park off Winterhaven; there is limited parking next to the pool and at the high school junior lot also off of Winterhaven. Snack bar may be available.

# Facility set-up and restriction:

There may be designated area(s) for athletes, coaches, and meet personal.

#### Water Depth:

The pool has 6 working lanes with a warmup area available. The minimum water depth measured in accordance with Article 103.2.3, is 6 feet, 0 inches at the start end and 3 feet, 6 inches at the turn end. There is a separate warm up pool (dive pool) that is 5 lanes and 20 yards

# Course Certification

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).

# USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers, coaches, and officials participating in this competition must be registered with USA Swimming (2025). All Coaches are required to complete the USADA Coaching Advantage, and all officials and coaches are to have completed Concussion Protocol Training. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

#### **Meet Format:**

Flyover starts may be used.

#### **Restrictions:**

Swimmers may enter up to 3 events.

This is a closed meet and is only open to SI swimmers and teams.

## Other Restrictions:

- Shaving is not allowed anywhere in the facility.
- Tobacco products of any kind, vaping, alcohol beverages, and glass containers are not allowed in the swimming venue.
- Trained service animals or service animals in training with identifiable vests will be

	allowed. Service animals must remain on a leash or be always in a harness.
Swimmers with Disabilities	FAST welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 105 to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and / or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit FAST's ability to accommodate all requests.
Qualifying Times:	There are no qualifying time standards.
Cell phone restrictions:	Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms and behind the start area behind the blocks.
Drone Restrictions:	Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) at any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
Deck Changing:	<u>Deck changes are prohibited.</u> Teams are encouraged to bring and use the Safe Sport changing tent.
12 & under Tech Suit Restriction:	102.8.1.F SWIMWEAR (USA Swimming Rulebook) No Technical Suits Shall be worn by any 12 & under USA Swimming athlete member in competition at any sanctioned, approved or observed meet (as of 9/1/2020).
Racing start Certification:	Any Athlete entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the athlete or athletes' legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
Officials:	Officials will be scheduled in advance with the minimum number of officials required set by the Officials Chair. All deck officials must be a member in good standing with USA Swimming and be able to show an up-to-date credential.
Timers:	Two Parent Volunteers per lane will be assigned to work back up buttons and stop watches.
Awards:	None
USA Swimming Meet 360:	Permanently suspended or ineligible individuals cannot be present on deck, coach, or perform any function at a meet requiring USA Swimming Membership.  During registration, ensure all coaches, officials, trainers, massage therapists, LSC or host club staff, and medical professionals show proof of current USA Swimming membership (e.g., require them to show their Membership Card via the USA Swimming app) at registration. If such an individual cannot demonstrate proof of membership in good standing, deck access will not be granted.  Individuals permanently suspended or ineligible can be spectators at a meet and may be in the stands.

 Violators shall be reported to the Meet Director or Meet Referee, who can then direct that individual to the spectator area. A subsequent report should also
